

Wamogo Middle School FFA Information

Middle school students can become members of the Wamogo FFA by completing their greenhand degree requirements (done in 7th grade class or by appointment with an agriscience teacher), filling out the permission slip form, middle school application form and by completing a membership form with dues (\$35 per year).

Once a student becomes a member they will be added to the Wamogo FFA eblast and are eligible to attend the events listed on the event page of this packet. Most events can be signed up for through the eblast or on the sign up sheet board in the agriscience building. They are also eligible to attend monthly chapter meetings which take place during period 1.

In addition students may sign up to be on an FFA team. These teams can be listed on the middle school ffa application.
