Parent Feedback Goal

Successes

- ▶ 96% of families contacted for a positive reason
- ▶ 73% of families contacted at least 5 times
- ▶ 30% of families contacted at least 10 times

Areas of Focus

- ▶ 4% not contacted at all (about 20 students)
- ▶ 13% of families contacted less than 3 times

Next Steps

- ▶ Prioritize second semester positive contacts for students that have not yet been reached

- ▶ Nearly 200 activities created or implemented, not including math classes
- ▶ Innovative approaches



SIP Progress (Assessment)

- ▶ Baseline data captured in October 2017 PSAT administration for all students in grades 9–11
 - ▶ Data analyzed and used for teacher goals
 - ▶ Post test for PSAT and SAT will be administered in March 2018
 - ▶ College Board and Khan Academy accounts created for all grade 9–11 students
 - ▶ An ongoing effort to have students link their college board accounts with Khan Academy is being completed
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SIP Progress (Assessment)

The days of large comprehensive SAT prep books and courses have given way to digital platforms that help to personalize learning for students. College Board and Khan Academy have joined forces to provide a customized experience which allows students to link their PSAT results from their College Board accounts to the powerful Khan Academy, which offers a practice and tutorial program. The PSAT results are used to inform the content priorities for each student. The table on the next slide illustrates the summary data of the percentage of students that have successfully linked their PSAT results to Khan Academy at the start of the year versus today.
