AGRICULTURAL ASSESSMENT PLAN

Following are the minimum standards of performance to maintain progression in the Agricultural Education program.

1. Student must be on track to graduate with their class.
2. Student has an accepted SAE project and is meeting the hour requirement as defined in the SAE project grading rubric.
3. Student is maintaining an acceptable level of behavior as determined by the ag center staff and administration of Wamogo High School.
4. Students must adhere to Wamogo attendance policy.

Monitoring:

1. Student progress will be reviewed quarterly by ag ed staff, guidance, and administration to identify students in danger of failing to meet any of those four criteria.
2. Parents of identified students will be notified by letter outlining issues of concern.
3. Review will be held mid-year and end-of-year for students not meeting the above criteria.
4. Should a student not meet the minimum standards outlined above by the end of the academic year, he/she may be recommended for removal from the program via the procedure detailed in the Administrative Handbook for Regional Vocational Agriculture Centers of the Connecticut Department of Education.
